YOUR FEEDBACK IN ACTION

On the wards and in the community

Here are a few highlights of the things that have been feedback to us and what we have done with that....

- FEEDBACK: More partner facilities and involvement throughout the maternity journey is needed
- IN ACTION: Partner project was launched to look at more access/involvement for partners considering safety, estate & service user feedback. Resources are being designed and more facilities such as air beds and reclining chairs have been purchased.
- FEEDBACK: More information / awareness on Pelvic health issues is needed
- IN ACTION: Perinatal Pelvic Health Service fully running along with a self referral process which is working well.
 Service user friendly coproduced leaflets and videos created also.
- FEEDBACK: More support and understanding of the needs of Neurodivergent (ND) service users is needed
- IN ACTION: ND in Maternity care working group set up to improve the experiences of these people and further educate the workforce. Service users also shared their stories at the LMNS Inclusion and Belonging conference in June.






